

COMMONS ACT 2006 – SECTION 15(1)

Notice of an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green (VG 234)

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below and to all other whom it may concern.

Application has been made to Hampshire County Council by Mrs. Janet Ticehurst of 1 Mardon Close, Swaythling, Southampton, Hampshire, SO18 2HP, under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007. The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town and village greens of the land described in the Schedule below, which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 14 September 2007 by virtue of a significant number of the inhabitants of the locality having indulged as of right in lawful sports and pastimes on the parcel of land known as 'Monks Brook' for at least 20 years and continue to do so.

The application, which includes a plan of the land proposed for registration, may be inspected in the Countryside Access Team's Office, Hampshire County Council, Room 0.01, Castle Avenue, Winchester, SO23 8UL between the hours of 09.00 and 16.30, Monday to Friday. Copies of the documents may also be inspected at the offices of Eastleigh Borough Council, Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh, Hampshire, SO50 9YN.

If the registration authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.

Any person wishing to object to the registration of the land as a town or village green should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based to the Commons Registration Section, Hampshire County Council, Room 0.01, Castle Avenue, Winchester, SO23 8UL on or before 12 August 2016. Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties.

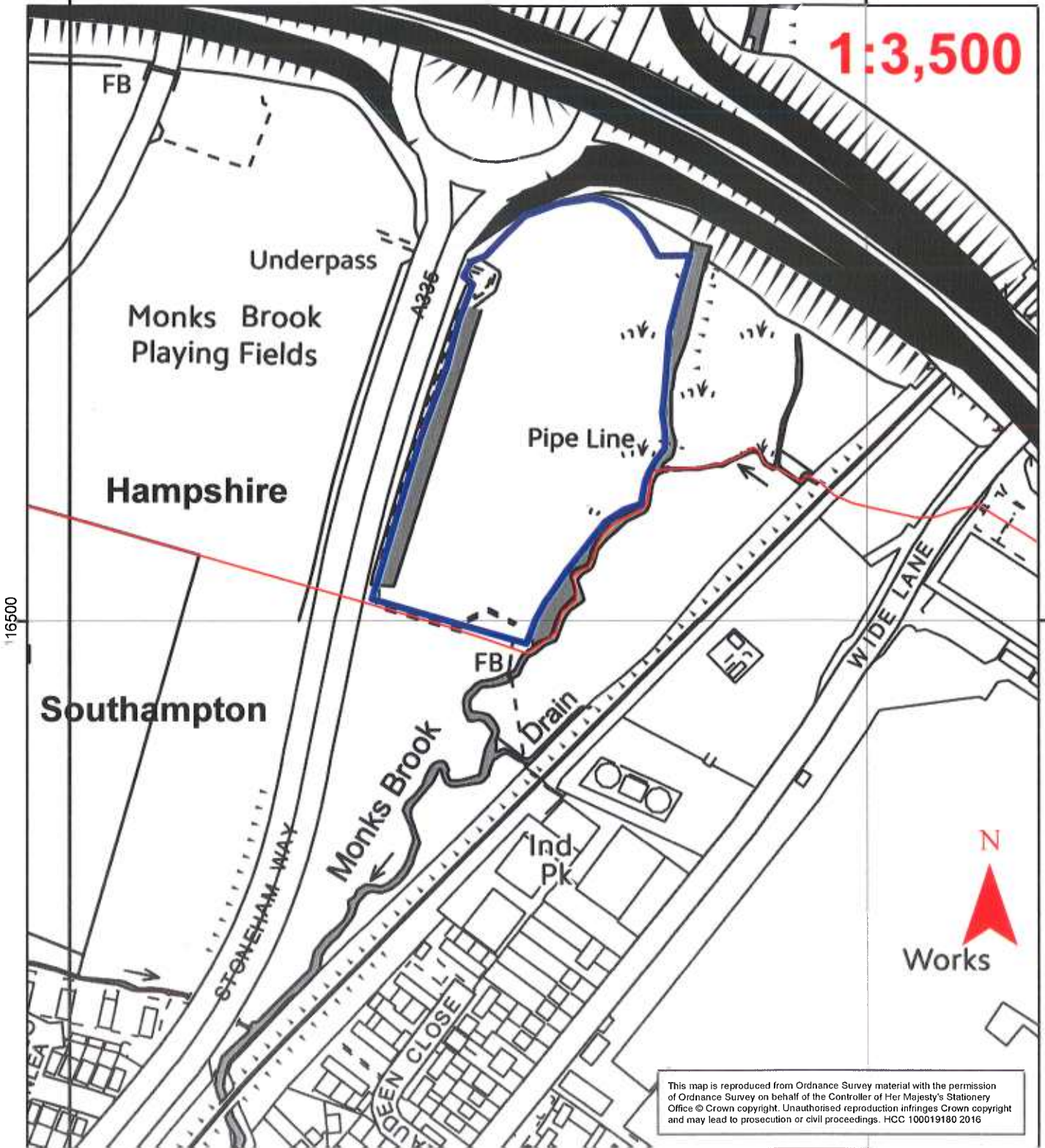
