## **RE – EASTLEIGH BOROUGH COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY No 724) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016 – MADE ON 26 MAY 2016**

On behalf of the Ramblers' Association I hereby lodge an objection to the above Order on the grounds that the Order if confirmed would create a situation where Footpath No 782 Bishopstoke at its northern end neither connects with the diverted Bridleway 724 nor Stoke Common Road because there would not be any public rights of way between the northern end and Point A on the Order plan.

In the introduction to the Order there should after "O/13/73660" (note it should be an "O" not a "0") be the words "and R/15/76716".
