THE EASTLEIGH BOROUGH COUNCIL (BOTLEY
FOOTPATH 2) DIVERSION (NO.2) ORDER 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 7 September 2018 Eastleigh Borough Council confirmed the above order without modification. The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from L to G and create an alternative footpath for use as a replacement to a line running from G-F-J-K-L and to include a spur from point J-D-E-C-B as shown on the order map.

A copy of the confirmed order and the order map may be seen at the Council Offices, Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh, SO50 9YN free of charge between 8:30am and 5:00pm Monday-Friday (excluding bank holidays and public holidays) for a period of 6 weeks from 7 September 2018. The order comes into force on the date on which the Council certifies that the terms of Article 4 of the order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
