RE – THE EASTLEIGH BOROUGH COUNCIL (HOUND FOOTPATH 1) DIVERSION ORDER 2018

On behalf of the Ramblers' Association I hereby object to the above Order on the following grounds.

1. The Plan attached to the Order is not on an Ordnance Survey mapping base that would enable the route of the proposed right of way to be accurately plotted on the ground or to enable the information to be translated onto the Definitive Map by way of a Legal Event Order.
2. It is not in a form that was envisaged by Regulation 2(2) of The Town and Country Planning (Public Path Orders) 1993 / No 10.
3. Better maps are readily available for this purpose.
4. The depiction of the proposed right of way by dashes is of such a width and so diagrammatic as to be lacking in sufficient precision as to its proposed location for the purposes of a Diversion Order.

This email is being copied to the Countryside Service of Hampshire County Council who maintain the Definitive Map.
